What's New in the MCIS Catalog The University of California, Irvine School of Medicine (UCSOM) is home to a unique collection of historic artifacts, including rare textbooks and art prints, original instruments, and historical photographs. The University Archives will continue to collect, preserve, and promote the achievements of the UCSOM through its Museum Collections. We are adding over 1,000 historic items into the University Archives collections. These include the USS Crawford, a World War II destroyer, and US Navy memorabilia such as medical equipment, training manuals, and many uniforms from the medical corps. We also have a collection of vintage books, including the 1956 edition of Mechanic's Medical Dictionary, and the UCSOM's first medical school publication, The M.D., issued in 1887. There are also several thousand historical photographs in the UCSOM Archives that date back to the 1880s. These images document the history of medicine at the University of California, Irvine and the early history of the medical school at the University of California, San Diego. The UCSOM Archives continues to process incoming items, and we are currently developing a system to create a searchable database. We hope to be able to share this new tool with the community soon.
