To open an image file, you need to follow these steps: Open the image file. If you want to open an image in Photoshop, click File>Open. If you want to open an image in Illustrator click File>Open. If the file type is not recognized, you'll get an error message. There are many formats. You can add a format if you have a lot of image files and do not know which one to use, but do check to make sure your PDF files are not corrupted. Choose a filename and click Open. The Department of Justice today announced the indictment of 13 individuals from China and Poland who allegedly engaged in a wide-ranging scheme to smuggle counterfeit and pirated goods into the United States using deceptive shipping labels. "The defendants are accused of lying about what they were shipping, and creating false shipping documents to evade law enforcement and consignees. This case is part of a larger Department of Justice investigation that disrupts the operations of counterfeiters in multiple countries," said Assistant Attorney General Leslie R. Caldwell of the Justice Department's Criminal Division and U.S. Attorney Dana J. Boente of the Eastern District of Virginia. According to the indictment, between November 2011 and May 2012, the defendants worked in a counterfeiting ring in which they allegedly manufactured and shipped counterfeit and pirated computer accessories from China and used deceptive shipping labels to pass them off as legitimate merchandise. Specifically, the defendants allegedly bought and shipped thousands of fake Bluetooth and Wi-Fi cables, touch pads, mouse pads, docks, and docking stations to retailers in the United States, Canada, and elsewhere. The charged company allegedly shipped hundreds of these counterfeit products to places in the United States including Maryland, Virginia, Minnesota, and Texas. Some of the products allegedly were shipped to stores in the District of Columbia and Florida and ultimately ended up in the hands of consumers. The defendants are charged with conspiracy to commit wire fraud, wire fraud, and money laundering. They were arrested on May 9, 2012 and are scheduled to appear before U.S. Magistrate Judge Dennis L. Bell in the Eastern District of Virginia. The FBI's Washington Field Office, aided by the U.S. Postal Inspection Service, the Customs and Border Protection Office of Field Operations, Homeland Security Investigations, the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement's Homeland Security Investigations, and the U.S. Customs and

The pro-business group Business & Media Coalition, meanwhile, said "\$90 million is a very big number.
