File formats: Vector images can be edited in Illustrator and Photoshop. If you're going to be doing mass changes to the same image, try exporting the image from Illustrator as a vector and then reimporting it into Photoshop. Adobe recommends that you use the EPS file format for vector images. EPS is a bitmap file format that retains information about the individual pixels in the image but is not compressed. You can choose between EPS and TIFF, depending on how you want to manipulate your images. In addition to Adobe Illustrator and Photoshop, other image-editing programs also offer some basic or light-duty photo editing. These programs include Adobe Photoshop Elements and Adobe Photoshop Express. Both are free and come with individual licenses that work on individual PCs only. You may want to consider purchasing a subscription to these programs; if you're going to edit images for a living, you'll find it helpful to have the ability to access the software anywhere. An even better option, of course, would be the Adobe Creative Cloud, which is a subscription-based digital photo management and editing tool. Photo editing is only included in the subscription for \$50 a month (though a \$20 upgrade to PhotoShop Elements will give you basic photo editing). You can try the online service for 30 days and see if it's for you. * * * Choose wisely Awareness about the difference between the free version and the paid one of Photoshop Elements is incredibly important. Many people think that the free version is the same as the paid one. That's not true. The free version is limited to basic photo editing features, and the images it can edit are limited to 30 images. (But if you want to be free, that's a small price to pay.) It doesn't include the tools or features you may need to edit a massive number of images. The paid version comes with unlimited access to your images, a library of Photoshop elements, and very useful templates to use in your work. Free isn't the same as all-purpose. * * * A note about the Adobe website Many of the links on this website direct you to Adobe's website for more information or purchase products. 737 S.W.2d 714 (1987) 287 Ark. 236 Michael David SPRADLIN and Raymond A. Salazar, Appellants, v. STATE of Arkansas, Appellee. No. CR 87-26. Supreme Court of Arkansas. July 22, 1987. Christopher G. Price, Hot Springs, for appellants. Brad Newman, Asst. Atty. Gen., Little Rock, for appellee. DUDLEY, Justice. Appellants, Michael Spradlin and Raymond Salazar, were convicted of kidnapping, kidnapping and rape, and sentenced to life imprisonment for each count. On appeal to the court of appeals, we affirmed the judgments of conviction. On petition for review we are concerned only with the propriety of the sentence. We hold that the trial court was clearly in error in sentencing both to life imprisonment. In the original sentencing the circuit judge said, "Court's ordered: The defendant, Michael David Spradlin and Raymond Salazar... are to serve a term of life imprisonment for their conviction of rape under Ark. Stat. Ann. § 41-1803 and a term of twenty-five years for their conviction of kidnapping under Ark. Stat. Ann. § 41-1801." The convictions of rape and kidnapping were based on separate incidents. Both were admitted to the deputy prosecutor by the appellants. The rape took place the day after the kidnapping. The trial court knew that the two life sentences were to be served consecutively. He sentenced them to the maximum punishment for kidnapping without consideration of the fact that this was a separate offense. He therefore acted without the benefit of our *715 rules on consecutive sentences. Ark.Cr.P. Rule 32.1. In Bateman v. State, 274 Ark. 63, 621 S.W.2d 180 (1981), we said: [W]e hold that imposition of consecutive sentences for offenses arising out of the same conduct is error where the trial court fails to find facts warranting a finding that the offenses were committed in a separate and independent manner. Thus, the case was remanded for resentencing. On the second appeal, we said in Bateman v. State, 285 Ark. 239, 686 S.W.2d 430 (1985): Appellants were convicted of eight counts of rape, two counts of kidnapping and one count of attempted rape. We hold that
