It can edit images, make selections, crop, resize, rotate, create black and white images, apply filters, convert to grayscale, combine multiple layers into one photo, and more. Like any graphic software, Photoshop Elements is not as complicated to learn as Photoshop itself, but once you are familiar with it, you may find yourself drawn to it because it has some features that you find missing in other

applications. Similar to Other Adobe Photoshop Alternatives Photoshop Elements is not a graphical editing program. It does not have a selection tool, a paintbrush, layers, contentaware-fill, healing tools, and many other features found in the professional version of Photoshop. It is a more basic program that is perfect for picture editing or basic graphics editing. The UI of Photoshop Elements looks like

the one for the first Photoshop—it is a basic graphic editing program with a very primitive UI. I'm not sure if the current default UI was the result of a design decision or it was simply the easiest and fastest to implement. You can edit, resize, change colors, add shapes, crop, adjust the color settings, and add a few basic effects. There is also a selection tool, but it is an

absolute beginner's tool and it has no means to select objects inside the canvas. If you want to work with the selection tool, then it will be the most basic tool for you. You have to manually crop, move, or select objects. It is somewhat useful but not a real selection tool. In fact, its name (the old name was "Move") implies that is a selection tool but it is not. If you want more advanced

tools, you are better off using a different application. In short, if you are looking for a very basic and basic editing program, Photoshop Elements is the perfect tool. If you want to learn more about graphic design, then you are better off downloading a more advanced program like Illustrator or Photoshop, or even GIMP if you are looking for a free tool. Good Alternatives To Photoshop

There are a few other wellknown graphic software that perform similar tasks, but I will only be mentioning the most notable alternatives.
